Brendan Bennett has been involved in advocacy for the profession for 30 years starting with directorship with the Canadian Association of Foot Professionals, then through the Canadian Federation of Podiatric Medicine as a director. Had several terms as president of the Nova Scotia Podiatry Association, working for legislative changes to the Provincial Statutes. He served for 10 years on the Podiatry Consortium for the Canadian Federal Agreement on Internal Trade where he was appointed as chairman. Brendan has been active in the policy, education, and regulatory aspects of the profession acting on the executive of local national, and international bodies (the CFPM, CPMA, ABPMI, CBCPM, and as a member of the GPN).

He has been a consultant to the Diabetes Care Program of Nova Scotia, and a Clinical Instructor for podiatry students through the University Health Network Toronto. He has also served as a member of the Macrovascular committee on the Diabetic foot in Nova Scotia guidelines and as an Ad Hoc faculty of Dalhousie Medical School.

He was awarded a Fellowship of the Faculty of Podiatric Medicine of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons (Glasgow), and the Fellowship of the Royal College of Podiatry in Podiatric Medicine.
