Dr. Jeffrey Jensen is currently Dean of, Arizona College of Podiatric Medicine, at Midwestern University in Glendale, Arizona. He also serves as the Chair of the American Association of Colleges of Podiatric Medicine (AACPM). He is board-certified by the American Board of Foot and Ankle Surgery and also co-founded the North Colorado Medical and Surgery Residency Program.

As an active researcher throughout his career, Dr. Jensen has generated over \$5.0M in research grants from the National Institutes of Health, the Department of Defense, and State organizations. This research has resulted in 14 patents for products addressing diabetic foot wounds, fractures, infections, and preventing head trauma.
