ALFRED GATT

Alfred Gatt is an Associate Professor at the University of Malta and a Fellow of the Faculty of Podiatric Medicine at the College of Physicians and Surgeons (Glasgow). After 20 years as Manager of Podiatry Services in Malta, he focused on academia and research, especially in relation to the biomechanics of the diabetic foot. He has published over 100 papers in various peer-reviewed journals and presented at leading Podiatry and Diabetes Conferences internationally. He is past President of the European Network of Podiatry in Higher Education (ENPODHE), founding Chair of the Association of Podiatrists of Malta, and the Diabetes Foot Research Group at the University of Malta. His work is based on 3D motion analysis, medical thermography in diabetes, rheumatoid arthritis, and CADCAM manufacture of custom foot orthoses. After obtaining several grants, he is currently working on medical devices aimed at the diagnosis and management of diabetic foot disease.
